**ORDER OF COURT GRANTING EXPEDITED HEARING AND SETTING  
RESPONSE DEADLINES ON THE CITY OF HARRISBURG’S EMERGENCY  
MOTION FOR AN ORDER CONFIRMING AUTHORITY OF CITY TO  
PAY PRE-PETITION CLAIMS OF CERTAIN VENDORS, SERVICE  
PROVIDERS EMPLOYEES, AND INSURANCE PAYMENT OBLIGATIONS**

Upon the Motion For An Expedited Hearing On The City of Harrisburg’s Emergency Motion For An Order Confirming Authority Of City To Pay Pre-Petition Claims Of Certain Vendors, Service Providers Employees and Insurance Payment Obligations (the “Request For Expedited Hearing”) filed by he City of Harrisburg, through its Mayor, the Honorable Linda D. Thompson (the “Movant”), and it appearing that Movant has shown sufficient cause to conduct a hearing on an expedited basis, the Court hereby ORDERS ADJUDGES and DECREES as follows:

1. The Request For Expedited Hearing is GRANTED as set forth herein.

2. The Court shall conduct a hearing on the City of Harrisburg’s Emergency Motion For An Order Confirming Authority Of City To Pay Pre-Petition Claims Of Certain Vendors, Service Providers Employees, and Insurance Payment Obligations (the “Motion”) on \_\_\_\_\_ at \_\_\_\_\_ am/pm in Bankruptcy Courtroom Number 1, Third Floor, Ronald Reagan Federal Building and Courthouse, Third and Walnut Streets, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania 17101.

Those individuals receiving notification of court filings via the CM/ECF electronic notification system shall be deemed to be served with a copy of the Motion and a copy of this Order on the dates that they are filed.
